


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### Café Mollien

Marvel at ornate columns, opulent decor and renowned masterpieces while enjoying a light lunch of cheese and bacon quiche, ham baguette, vegetable soup, pain au chocolat or apple pie with specialty tea or coffee. The balcony is punctuated by atlantes and caryatids that overlook the Carrousel gardens. Leonardo da Vinci's famous painting, Mona Lisa, is within stumbling distance of this cafe.

### Aki Boulanger


"Fusion Bakery"

## Bread & Roses


### "Modern French Cafe"

### "Franco-German Encounter"


