"Bar of the World"





The bar and viewing gallery are located on a rooftop above Singapore's Financial District and have unobstructed views in all directions. A fixed price for the first drink (whether it's alcoholic or non-alcoholic) serves as the cover charge. There is a fine selection of fruit cocktails, whiskeys, wines, and beers. 1-Altitude is largely a tourist attraction by day, but after 10p all guests must be 21 or older and observant of the dress code.
