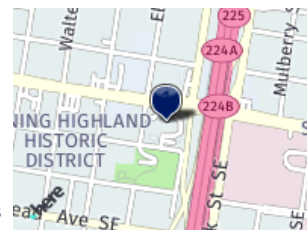

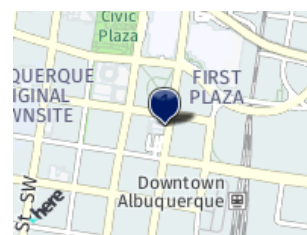

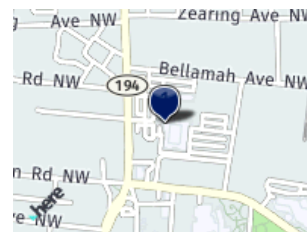

"See The City"

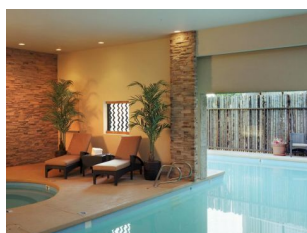

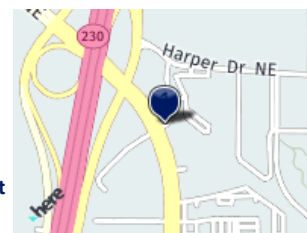
