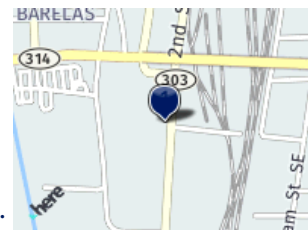

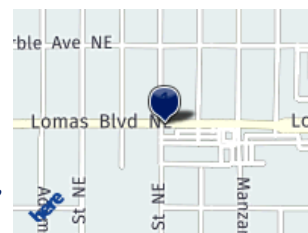

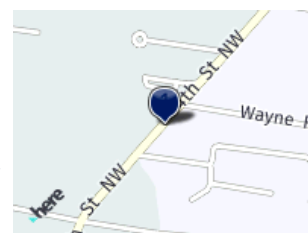

### Casa de Benavidez

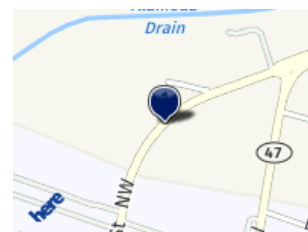
"Outdoor Patio, Strolling Mariachi's"
