Leonidas Chocolates

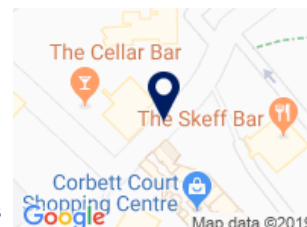
"Delicious, handmade Belgian chocolates"

Galway Atlantaquaria

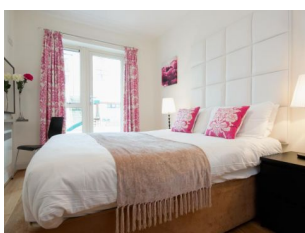
"See the diverse denizens of the deep"

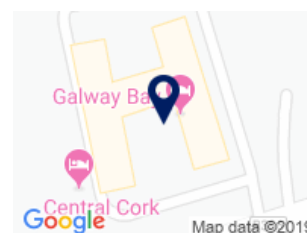

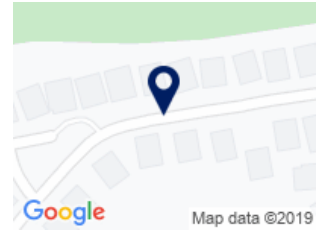
Renville Park

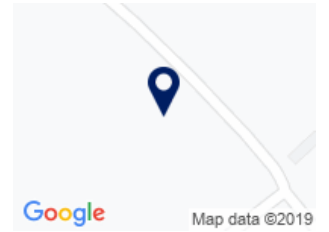
Rockmount Riding Centre

"Fairy Tale Garden"

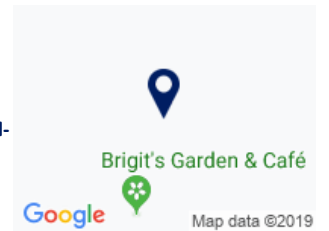
