





One of the city's most exquisite examples of art nouveau architecture, the near 100-year-old Hotel Pariz is a Prague landmark that is known for its sumptuous attention to detail. 

Reopened in 1989 after being closed for over two decades, this elegant hotel sports classy art nouveau lines and curves. 





"Relax with Some Music"

The luxurious Aria Hotel is located in the historical Mala Strana quarter in the historic centre of Prague. Free wired high-speed internet access is available. Away from the crowds but only 30 metres from the tram line, guests can reach the Old Town within a 15-minute walk across Charles Bridge. An extensive music and DVD library, Ipad in the room are part of each room. All guests receive a free welcome drink. In the afternoon, snacks and drinks are offered free of charge. From the rooftop garden terrace, guests can enjoy direct views of the city. The on-site Coda restaurant serves Czech and international cuisine in the dining room or on the terrace. The Aria Hotel provides direct access to the Baroque Vrtbovska Gardens. The Garden is open from April until the end of October.



The atrium is filled with fountains, exotic flora and soft leather couches. The hotel caters mainly to business people and groups of travelers with cash to blow. The rooms are pleasant but lack the presentation and spirit of other luxury hotels. An endless list of guest services and facilities leaves next to nothing which cannot be arranged. Its list of distinguished guests include the Clintons and Nelson Mandela. Guests can enjoy Cloud 9 Sky Bar & Lounge, a rooftop bar with breathtaking views.





Novotel Praha Wenceslas Square

"Quintessentially Novotel"

Set in the very heart of Prague, Novotel Praha Wenceslas Square is 100 metres from the I.P. Pavlova public transportation hub. The Wenceslas Square is only a 5-minute walk away. The National Museum is only 400 metres away and the Prague Congress Centre is 3 km away.






