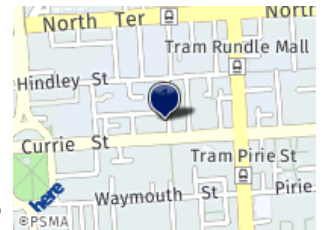

"Dancing with Stars"

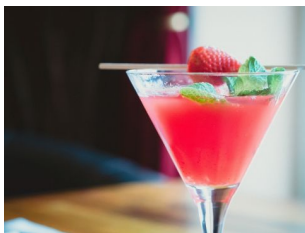
