"Food and Hospitality Since 1837"

Since 1837, the name Schwables has been associated with good food and hospitality. This restaurant, at its current location since 1946, is noted for its roast beef, particularly their beef on weck sandwich, served with homemade German potato salad. Other menu items include homemade soups, hot roast turkey breast (served as a sandwich or dinner) ham dinner, roast beef dinner, and a variety of seafood items, including yellow



pike, haddock, scallops, and shrimp. They also serve their famous Hungarian goulash and dumplings, which seem to be loved by most of their patrons. If you visit between Thanksgiving and St. Patrick's Day, enjoy a Tom and Jerry, a very old-fashioned cocktail made with egg better, rum and brandy which is served in vintage carnival glass cups. During the warmer months, Memorial Day to Labor Day, a popular liquid libation is Ebenezer Punch, a blend of orange and lemon juice, Southern Comfort, and lemon lime soda.



Charlie the Butcher's

"Best Beef on Weck"

This tiny, old-fashioned diner is operated by Charlie Roesch, who many consider to be the food ambassador of western New York. The regional favorite of beef on weck is why you come here. Freshly sliced roast beef comes served on a salt-encrusted kummelweck roll. It's actually the "weck" roll, a kaiser-like roll topped with Kosher salt and caraway seeds, that makes the sandwich. Often Charlie himself, wearing his trademark butchers apron and white hard hat, can be seen behind the counter carving the beef himself. During the warmer months, you can dine outdoors on picnic tables. He also provides efficient catering.


