"African American History"



"Have Fun Learning"



Arkansas River Trail



"Get Back to Nature"

This system of trails spans over 34 miles (54.7 kilometers) and loops around the city through various neighborhoods, parks, along the river and wooded areas. Outdoor recreation enthusiasts flock to the Arkansas River Trail to take advantage of diverse opportunities like cycling, jogging, skating and walking. The relatively flat terrain means people of all ages and fitness levels can use this paved path for their enjoyment. The riverfront area is especially picturesque with cottonwood trees lining the banks of the expansive Arkansas River, where river barges and fishing boats can also be seen.

The Arkansas Maritime Museum tells the heroic tale of the USS Razorback. The legendary submarine came back without any major damages after its various escapades in World War II and the Vietnam War. It was later sold to Turkey in the 1970s. Restoring the legend of the ship became essential and hence was brought to the Little Rock in 2004, to be displayed in the Maritime Museum. The graphic account of the war means children are advised against the tour. Hours vary as per season.
