
### Quapaw Quarter Association


### Little Rock River Market



### Stiff Station Historic District

"Historic District of Stiff Station"

The Stiff Station Historic District is a historic area that dates back to 1906. The district has a mix of architectural styles but the most prominent ones include the Late 19th and 20th Century Revivals and American Movements. There are 238 structures that contribute to the historic nature of this district. Primarily a residential area, this beautiful district was designed by architect Theodore Sanders. The district became a part of the National Register of Historic Places due to its historic significance.



### Hillcrest Historic District

"Historic Neighborhood"

Just west of Downtown Little Rock lies the popular and historic neighborhood of Hillcrest. On the National Register of Historic Places, Hillcrest was established at the end of the 19th Century and continued to grow throughout the beginning of the 20th Century and beyond. One main characteristic of the area is the wide variety of interesting and aesthetically pleasing architectural styles of the homes. Within the Hillcrest Historic District are landmarks like Little Rock's former town hall.



Hillcrest in recent years has become a hub of entertainment as well with numerous bars, restaurants, shops and galleries, among other things.
