"Iconic Theater"

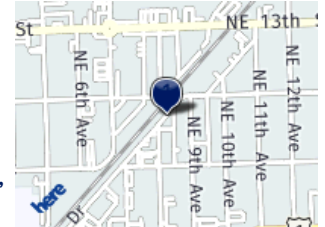

### Parker Playhouse

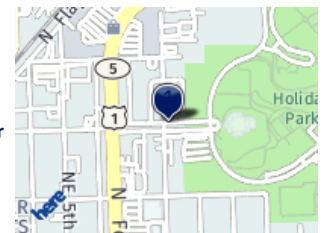
"Local Theater"

"The Theatrical Hub"

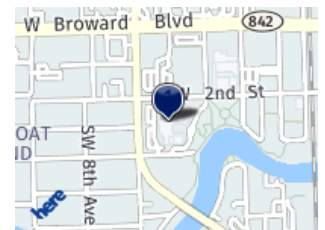
