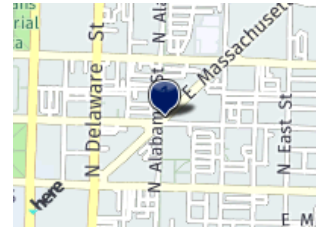

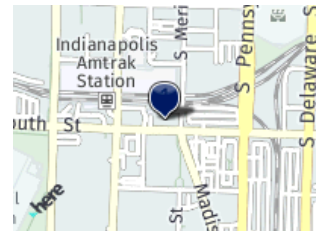

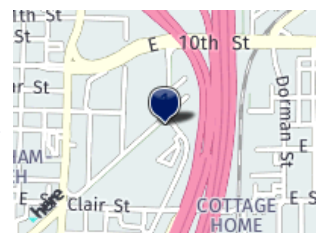

"Cajun & Creole Catharsis"

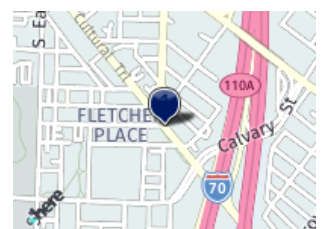
