"Diverse Selection of Art"

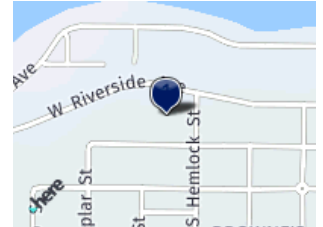

"Historic House"

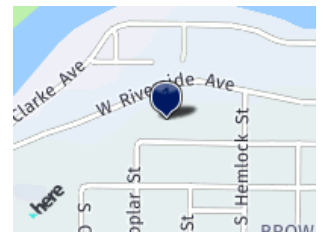

The stunning house was created with an English style and included a two story main house, a service wing and a carriage house. There are several tours available, including tours explaining the lives of the people who lived there and functional tours showing how items in the house worked.

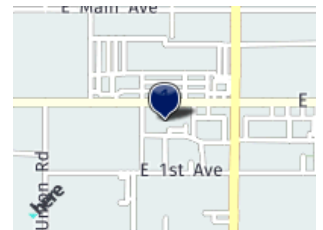
Spokane Valley Heritage Museum
