Bar du Marché des Blancs Manteaux


"Small Bites & Beer!"


Le Loir dans la Théière

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

Café Mollien

Take the regal marble stairway to Café Mollien at the Musée du Louvre, which is home to several dining alternatives. 
Au Sauvignon

"Good for the Mind & Spirit"




