"Traditional Japanese Grill"

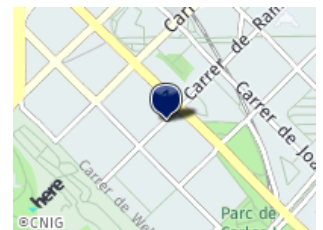

Els Pollos de Llull

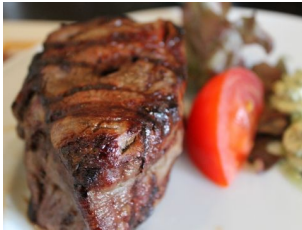
"Roast Chicken Specialists"
