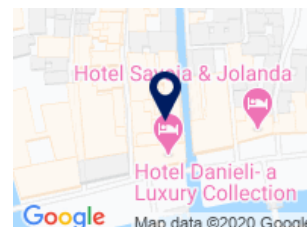

"Historic Hotel in an Elegant Palace"

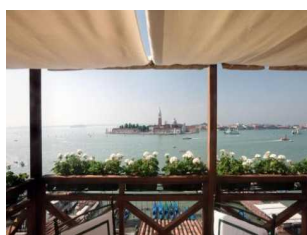

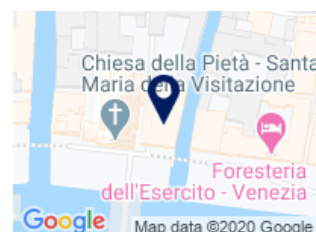

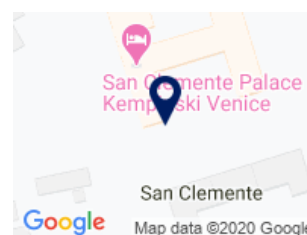
