"Many Varieties"

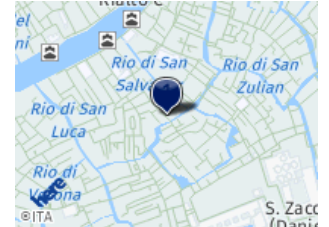

"Hemingway's Favorite Restaurant"

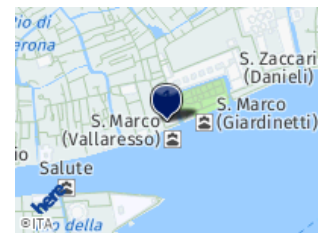

"Up to the Minute Restaurant"

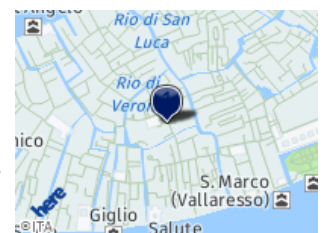
