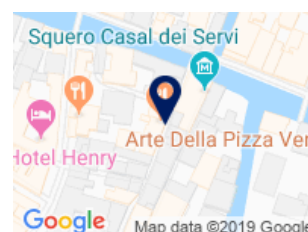
### Pizza al Volo
