"Roots Rock & Elvis Tributes"

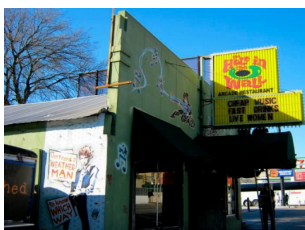

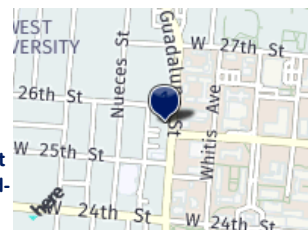

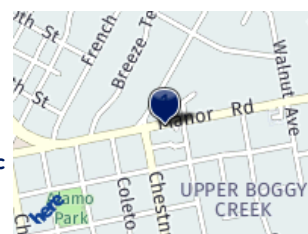
