"Classic & Romantic Dining"

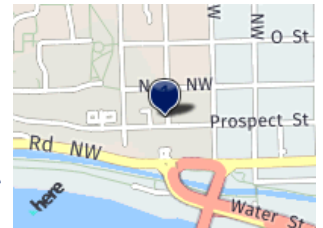
