"All-Day Dining"

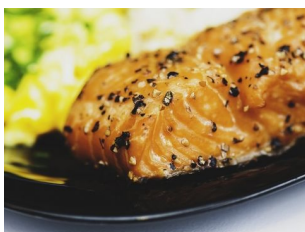

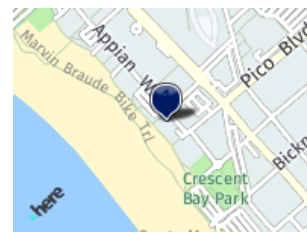
