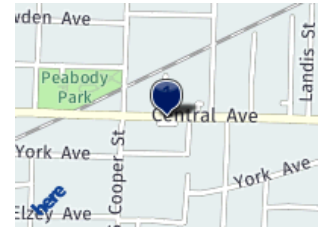

"Retro Furniture, Clothing & Accessories"

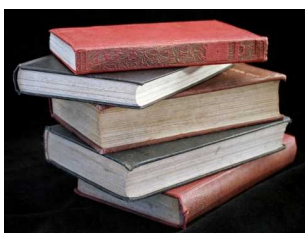
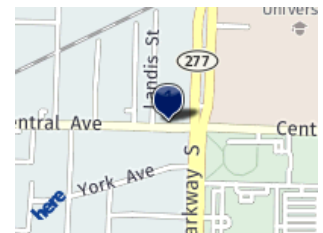

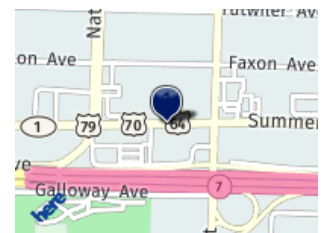
Chip-N-Dale's Antiques
