

"San Diego Wine Excursions"

Vine Idea are wine excursions that visit various wineries throughout San Diego county, with the focus of introducing people to California's newest side of wine country. Each excursion includes a visit to at least two wineries in Escondido Valley, Ramona Valley, and Julian; and they usually include five to six one ounce pours of their most exclusive or award winning wines. For those who would like to book an all day excursion, they must do so months in advance to allow time for booking of transportation and at vineyards. Vine Idea is also able to accommodate private excursion or groups of up to 35, but they recommend the smaller the group the more intimate the experience.



Baja Vino Tours

"Tours Across the Border"

These wine tours, which explore Mexico's wine country, are bilingual guided tours that leave from San Diego's Old Town. Each tour includes wine tastings at three wineries and a wine glass to keep as a souvenir. Among the most commonly visited wineries are La Cetto, Santo Tomas, and Vina Liceaga; and tour guests will have a chance to enjoy their lunch at the second winery they visit. For lunch, Baja Vino Tours works with a taqueria in Ensenada that provides a variety of tacos, quesadillas, beans, guacamole, and more. Those who wish to join Baja Vino Tours must make reservations, as well as they must carry proof of U.S. residency. - Erick Pettersen



Barrels rest on steel shelving units behind a long counter and below the high warehouse ceiling of Green Flash Brewing Company. Guests can stand at another counter, where bartenders stand ready to serve guests their choice of beer. Among their wide selection of beers, they offer a Double Stout Black Ale (brewed with oats and roasted malts), Saison Diego (brewed with Orange peels and ginger), and the East Village Pilsner (brewed with more hops than European pilsners). For those unable to go to the Green Flash Brewing Company, they sell their beers at various retailers throughout the United States. This brewery also contains a gift shop which offers shirts, hats and glassware.
