Star Pizza

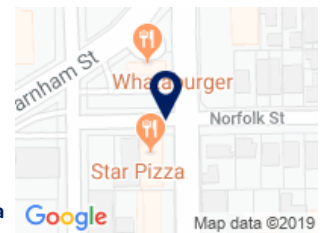
"Local Favorite"

"24-hour Dining and Desserts"

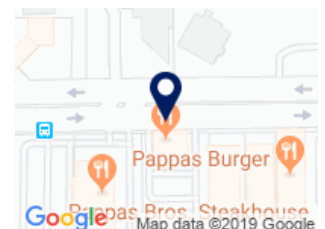
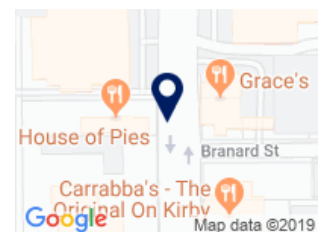

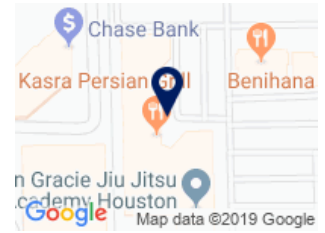
