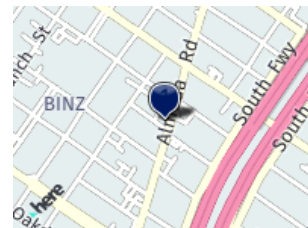

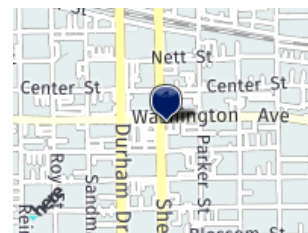

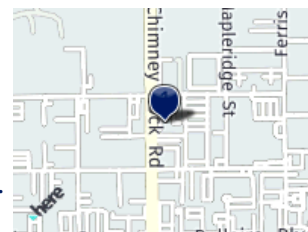

Nazareth Cafe

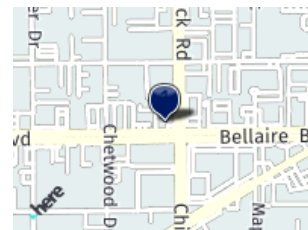
"Exotic Eats"

Cafe Piquet

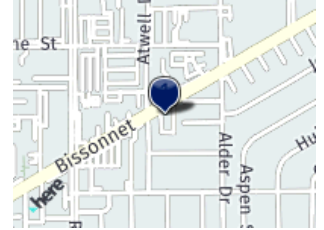
"Revolutionary Cuban Cuisine"

Lucy Ethiopian Restaurant and Lounge

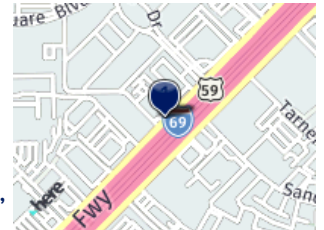
"Trendy Ethiopian Lounge"

Blue Nile

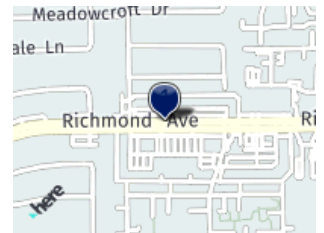
"Award Wining Ethiopian Restaurant"

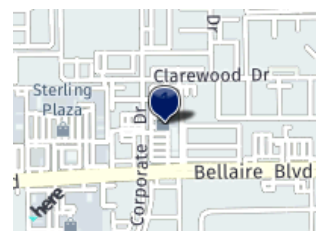

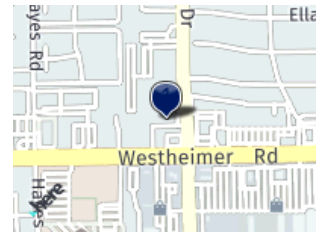

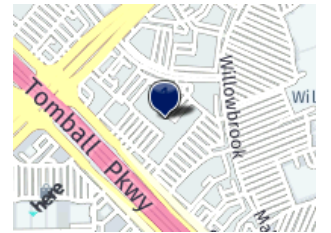
