

The CF Rideau Center is a massive shopping center located in Downtown Ottawa. With three levels of over 200 luxury brand stores, restaurants and services, it is a great place to power shop or simply spend a relaxed day. Dispersed among the regular slate of chain stores like the Disney Store and Eddie Bauer are several specialty shops that are worth a visit : Miss Tiggy Winkles, a toy store with something for kids of all ages; Ottawa Souvenir and Gifts, which sells everything from maple candy to t-shirts and the Canadian Geographic Shop. The shopping center is set in a complex which also houses the luxurious Westin Hotel, Ottawa Convention Center and a perfectly manicured rooftop park.






