Club Voice

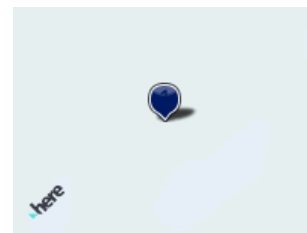
"Let the Music Play"

Hot Shot

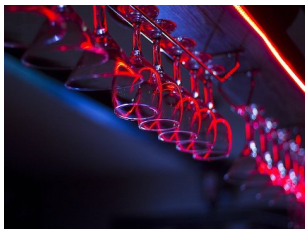
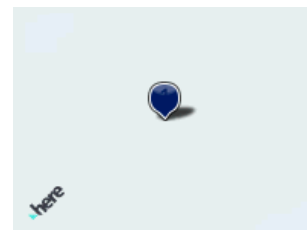
"Go Wild"

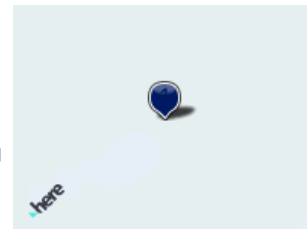

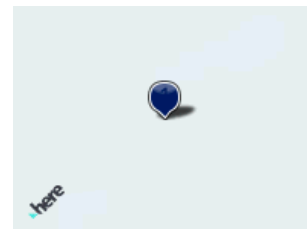
Fireking Cafe

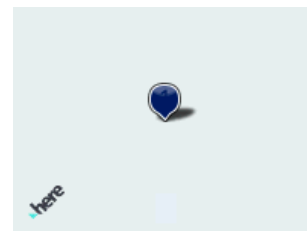





Shelter
