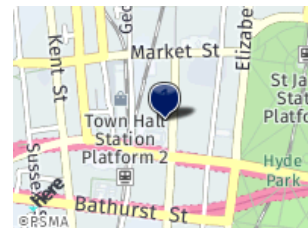

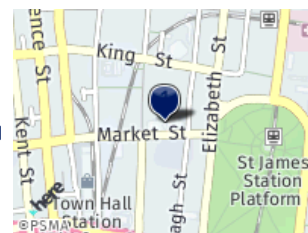

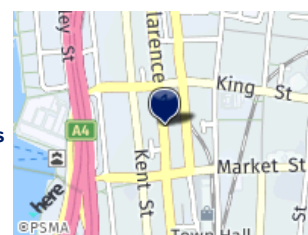

"Wall of Whiskey!"

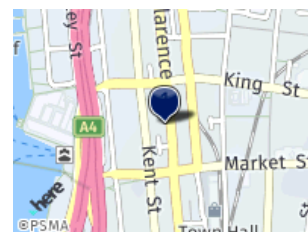

### "Brewed to Perfection"

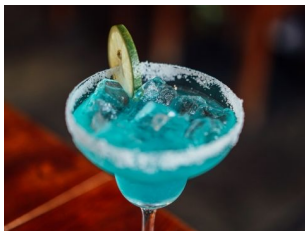

### "Spirits And A View"

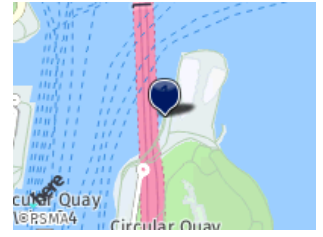

### "Premium Wine Collection"

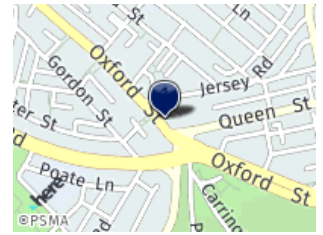

### "Iceberg Straight Ahead"

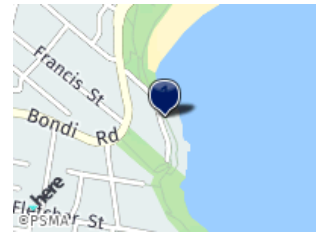

### "The Good Old Neighborhood Pub"

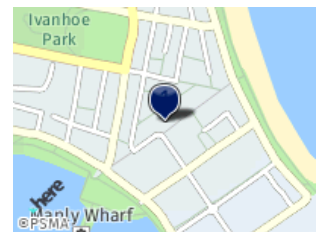
