

Within 15 minutes' walk of St Kilda Beach and sea baths, Ritz For Backpackers offers 500 MB of free WiFi, free daily breakfast supplies including pancake mix, coffee, tea and jam, regular night activities and free locker use. The hostel is a 10-minute drive from both Melbourne Arts Centre and Rod Laver Arena. Melbourne Airport is 25 minutes' drive away. Guests have access to a shared kitchen, a lounge area with a large cinema screen and a spacious common area with satellite TV. There is also a games room with a billiards table, a guest laundry and a terrace with outdoor furniture. Free pasta and rice are also provided in the communal kitchen. Activities include BBQs, trivia, movie nights, pool competitions and games.

Located on the city fringe, Melbourne Metro YHA boasts a rooftop terrace offering panoramic views of Melbourne. It is just 600 metres from the Queen Victoria Market and 1 tram stop from the Free Tram Zone. Free WiFi is available in public areas, WiFi in the rooms is available for an additional charge. Guest facilities includes a fully equipped shared kitchen, a laundry room and a communal lounge area with a TV and DVD player. Breakfast is available for an additional charge each morning. There are regular recreation events such as movie nights, wine and cheese nights, comedy shows and a weekly pub crawl. The friendly staff can assist with tour bookings to the Grampians, Phillip Island and Apollo Bay. There are also yoga and aerobic classes available, a billiards table, and YHA Metro Melbourne is 1 km from Melbourne Central Train Station and 2.5 km from the Melbourne Zoo. Melbourne International Airport is 21 km away. Each room is heated and includes secure lockers and an individual bed light. Bathroom facilities are shared. Private double, twin and family rooms are available, along with dormitory rooms.
