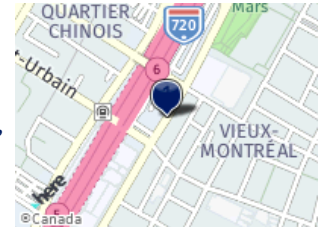

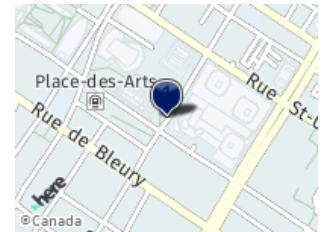

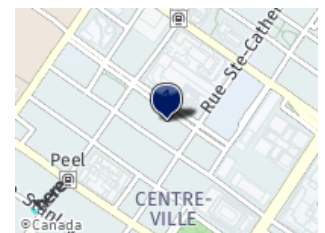

"Books and Bites"

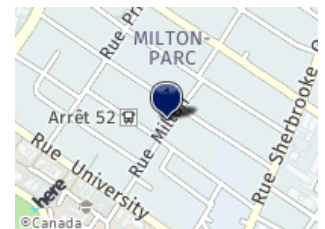

### "Original & Still the Best"

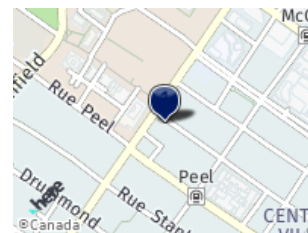

### "Literary Criticism"

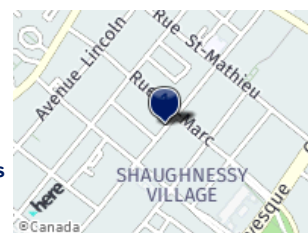

### "Extensive Selection of Titles"

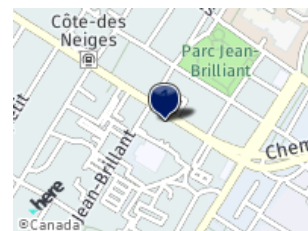
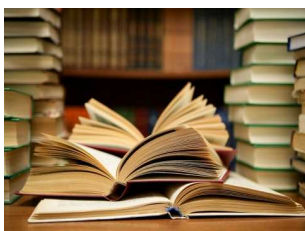
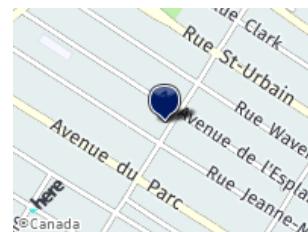
