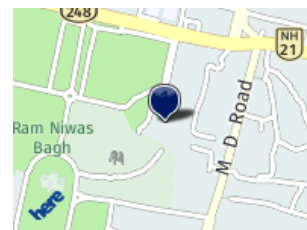

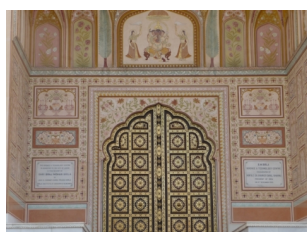
"A Cultural Phenomenon"

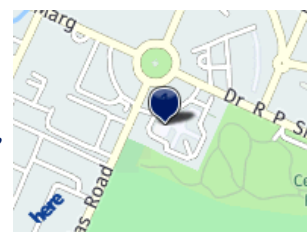

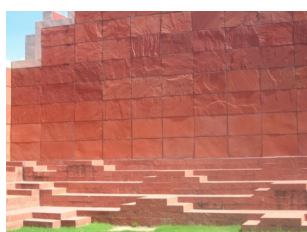

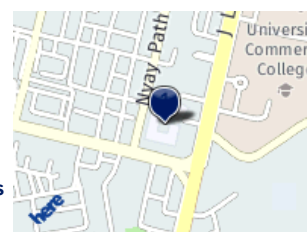
