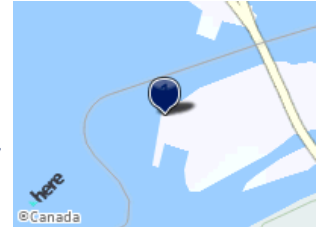

Chaudière Falls

"Magnificent Cascade"

Located on the fringes of the Chaudière Island, Chaudière Falls is a group of waterfalls flowing into the Ottawa River. These falls were discovered by Samuel de Champlain in the 17th Century and are named Chaudière, meaning 'Big Kettle', as the shape resembled that of a cauldron. The drop of the fall is 15 meters (49 feet), and the set stretches for 60 meters (200 feet). The force of this falling water is used to generate hydroelectric power.

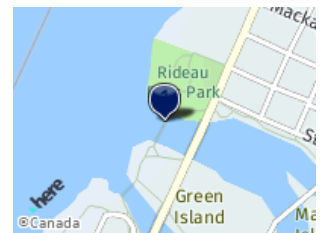

Chutes Rideau

"Chutes d'eau pittoresques"

Situées en face du City Hall d'Ottawa, sur Sussex Drive, ces charmantes chutes marquent la fin de la ballade de la Rideau River, au départ de la St. Lawrence River. Bien qu'elles ne soient pas aussi impressionnantes que les Hog's Back Falls, les Rideau Falls restent très charmantes, surtout lorsque la lumière de la tombée du jour s'y reflète. Elles sont situées dans le Rideau Falls Park, à quelques pas du 24 Sussex Drive et du Rideau Hall.

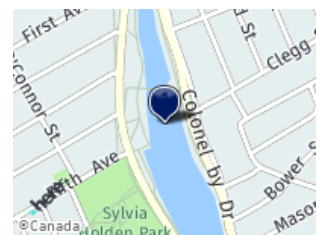

Canal Rideau

"Véritable artère"

Construit sans l'aide des machines, entre 1827 et 1832, ce canal est un des symboles les plus anciens d'Ottawa. Il s'étend de Parliament Hill à Chutes Hog's Back, au Sud de la ville. Pendant l'été, un grand nombre de bateaux s'y laissent glisser, pendant que les vacanciers se balladent sur ses quais. En hiver, le canal se transforme en gigantesque patinoire et accueille le Festival Winterlude.

Hog's Back Falls, formally known as the Prince of Wales Falls, are artificially created waterfalls. Located on the Rideau River, the falls make for a perfect day trip.
