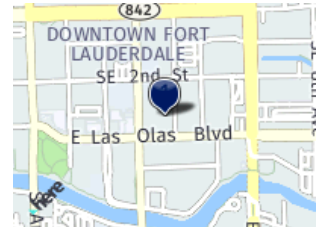

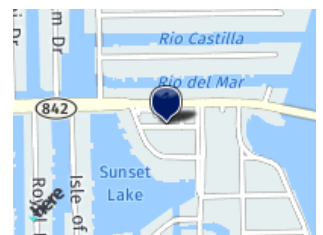

"Meat Gluttony"

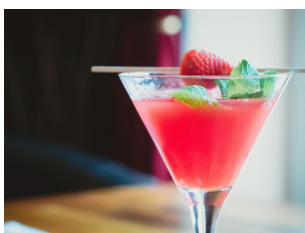

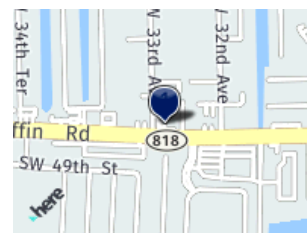
The Field Irish Pub & Eatery
