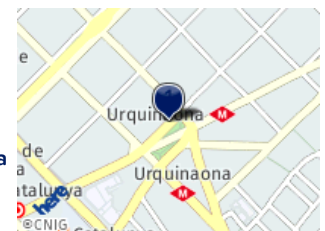
The George Payne Irish Bar

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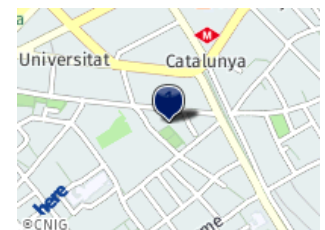
Kasparo

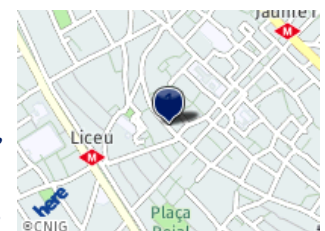

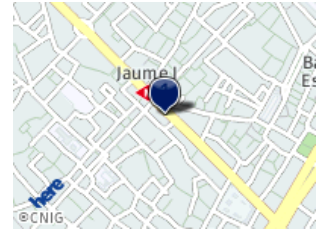



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Dunnes

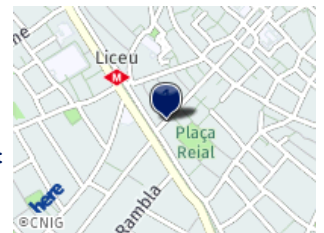



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The Temple Bar

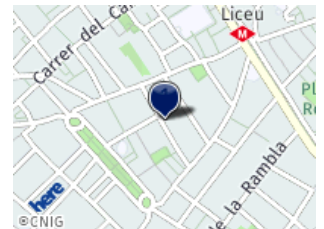



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Robadors 23

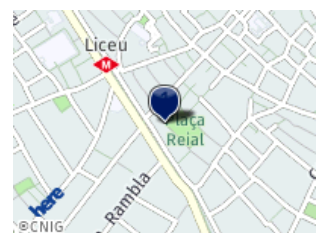

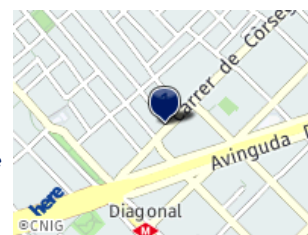


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La Pepita

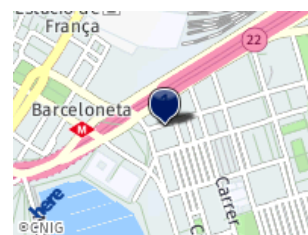


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El Vaso de Oro

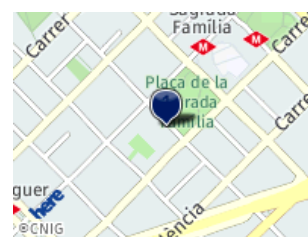


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Michael Collins

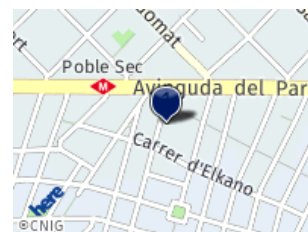


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Tinta Roja Espai d'Art

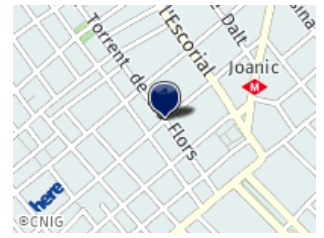

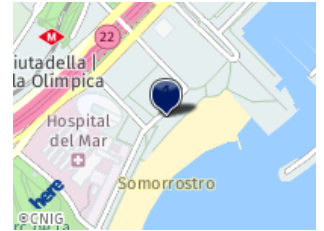
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Carpe Diem Lounge Club
