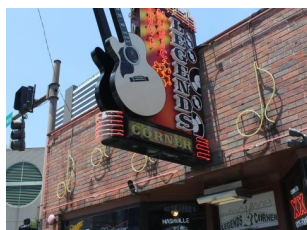

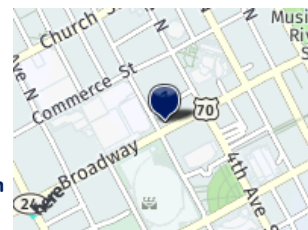

"Amazing Honky Tonk"

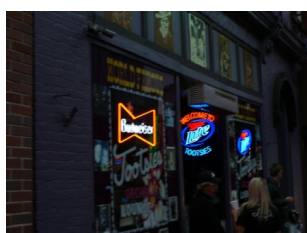
