"Open Square"

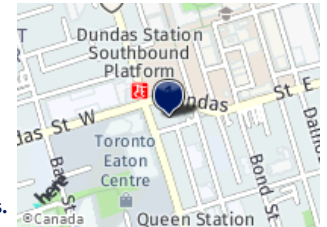

"Outdoor Entertainment"

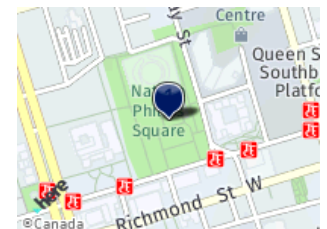

"Zoals een Reis om de Wereld"

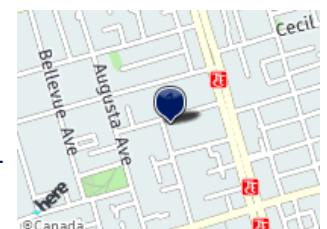

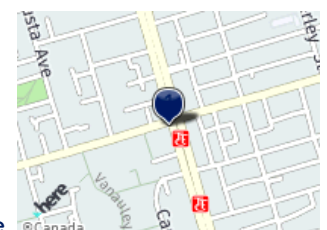


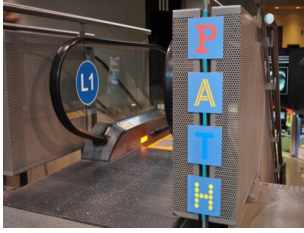
### Chinatown

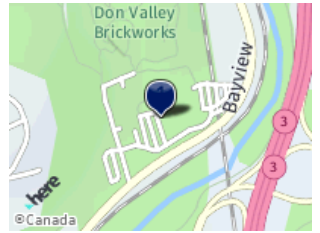


## Evergreen Brick Works

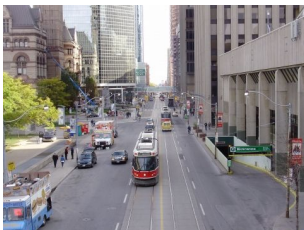
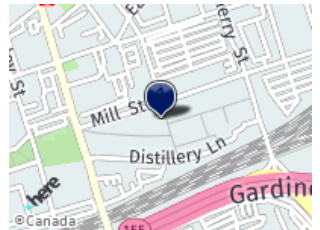


## Distillery Historic District

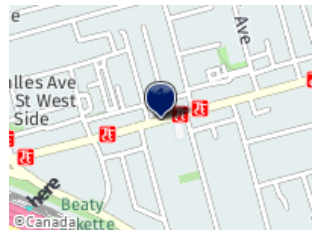


## Queen Street West

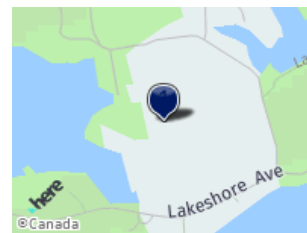
