"Multipurpose Venue"

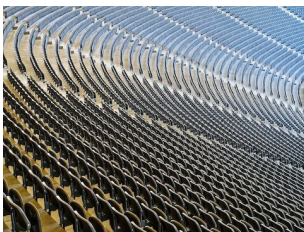

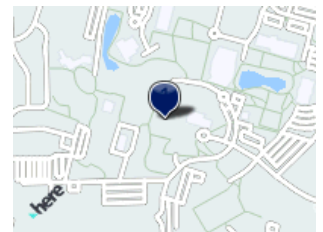

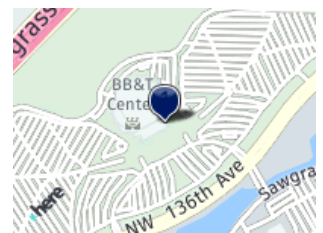
