"Interactive Science & Technology Museum"

Developed by physicist Frank Oppenheimer and opened in 1969, this innovative and interactive museum is dedicated to art, science and human perception. Relocated from the Palace of Fine Arts to Piers 15 and 17, the modern space features plenty of new green technologies including the largest solar panel roof in San Francisco and offers over 600 hands-on exhibits. These hands-on displays unveil the mysteries of science and language, and present these theories simply and succinctly. Webinars, special events and seminars occur throughout the year. This San Francisco gem is a must visit.

California Academy of Sciences

"New, Improved World of Science"

Located in Golden Gate Park, the California Academy of Sciences is one of the greenest buildings in the city and has a platinum certification from the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED). The museum features the newly renovated and expanded Steinhart Aquarium, complete with a hands-on tide pool and the well-known alligator swamp. Other exciting features are the Morrison Planetarium, the four-story rain-forest dome, and the Hall of African Mammals. In addition to these educational gems, the museum features other natural history exhibits as well as exhibits about global warming. The Academy Cafe offers international cuisine, while the elegant Moss Room restaurant is the only dining option available in the park past museum closing time.

Bay Model Visitor Center

"Vermakelijk Wetenschappelijk Gereedschap"

Met twee acres, is dit binnenhuis schaalmodel van de San Francisco Bay en haar schatten een van de grootste in de wereld. Het wordt gebruikt door de Ingenieurs van het Army Corps om de effecten te testen van de ontwikkeling van de kustlijn, lekkages van giftige stoffen en weersomstandigheden. Het complex is open voor publiek een indrukwekkend gezicht. Een complex systeem van hydrolische pompen, pompt water in en uit het model om eb en vloed van de echte getijden na te bootsen. Voor de ecologist, de oceanograaf of de ingenieur is er geen betere attractie.
