Opened in 2012, Up At The O2 allows visitors to climb over the famed O2 dome using a walkway suspended by the O2's masts. The summit is the viewing platform- 53 meters (174 feet) above the ground offering a panoramic view of the Thames Barrier, The Shard, Canary Wharf and Anish Kapoor's ArcelorMittal Orbit. The climb and descent, although not steep, are guaranteed to get your adrenaline pumping. Each expedition is guided by expert climbers and visitors are strapped in safety harnesses and special suits. Booking ahead is highly recommended and priority tickets are also available.

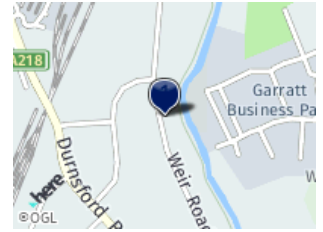




Dive Wimbledon

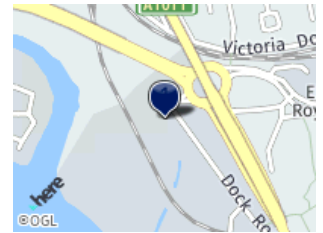

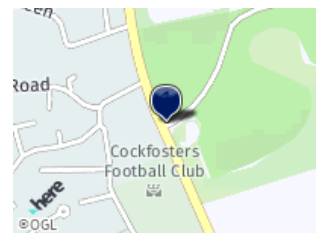

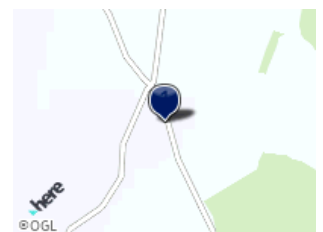
