"Intimate & Full of Delights"

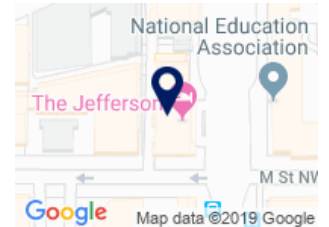

"Ornate Downtown Hotel"

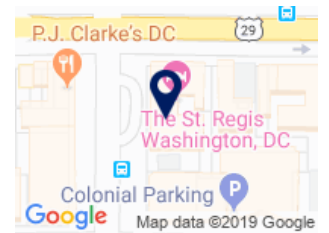

Morrison-Clark Historic Inn

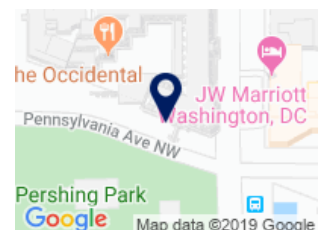
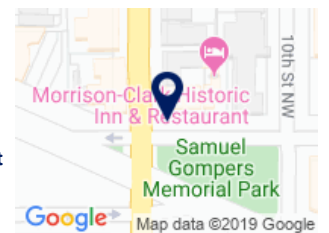
"Renovated Townhouse"

The White House is 2.3 km from The Churchill Hotel Near Embassy Row and The Phillips Collection Art Gallery is 483 metres away. Smithsonian National Zoological Park is 1.8 km from this historic hotel.

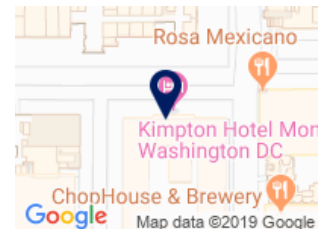

Hotel Monaco in Washington, DC, located in the historic Tariff Building, used to be one of the city's most prominent historical landmarks. In the old days, this lovely four-star hotel was the General Post Office's building, also known as the Tariff building. Refurbished in 2002, the boutique hotel boasts spacious, well-equipped rooms that are perfect for any weary and discerning traveler. Designed by Robert Mills, architect of the Washington Monument, this building was completed in 1842 as the first all-marble building in the city.
