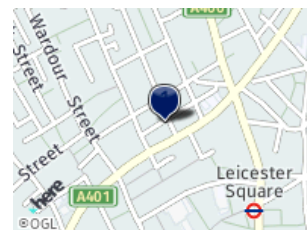
### Soho

### Covent Garden Piazza

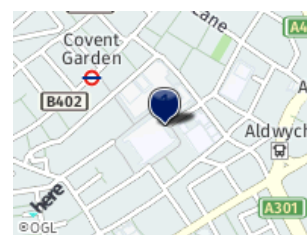
"Mímica, Mercado e Museu da Mecânica"

Esta área foi antigamente a sede do mercado Londrino de frutas e produtos hortícolas, que hoje deslocou-se para o New Covent Garden Market em Bermondsey. Hoje, é um conjunto de lojas que vendem uma variedade de bens, de antiguidades e artesanato de imagens e vestuário artesanal. Há também uma área ao ar livre onde espetáculos de mímica e malabarismos podem, ocasionalmente, ser encontrados. Músicos tocam regularmente nos bonitos pátios em torno das lojas do mercado. Também há alguns lugares para almoçar ou pegar um sorvete.

"London's Busiest Street"

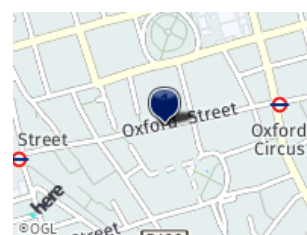
Visiting Oxford Street is essential on any trip to London. Towards the end of the 18th Century, it was bought by the Earl of Oxford and soon after this, Oxford Street started to become popular for shopping. When Debenhams and Selfridges opened in 1909, the street became the place to go to for good quality shops. It now has over 600 shops and there are over 200 bars, cafes and restaurants in close walking distance as well as many other places of interest. Many of the more popular stores consider their branch in Oxford Street to be the flagship store and the one where they have their special openings and promotions.

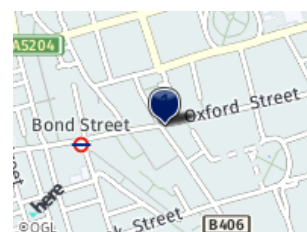

### Bond Street

"Chique Design"

Nomeada pelo Sir Thomas Bond, o controlador financeiro dos gastos domésticos da rainha na corte do rei Charles I no século 17. A área da rua Bond (Bond Street) era uma zona pantanosa, desabitada e perto de um buraco da praga – uma área repelente onde ladrões de estrada buscavam suas vitimas e nobres lutaram duelos. Nos anos 1850, no entanto, Bond Street tinha sofrido uma espécie de renascimento e tornou-se um lugar repleto de lojas modernas, onde os membros da alta sociedade passeava.



Ela manteve-se assim, embora hoje os principais visitantes são os turistas e os consumistas em geral. No entanto, Bond Street ainda tem muitos comerciantes que exibem o mandado real mantendo uma tradição de serviço individual, com muitas casas líderes da moda com roupas feita à medida podem ser adquiridos. Para os amantes de arte, da roupa elegantes, jóias e dos artigos de couro, não há lugar igual a Bond Street. A mudança das importantes marcas para o local tem ajudado a manter esta reputação - tais como Donna Karan, Calvin Klein e Louis Vuitton - recentemente abiram lojas neste local.

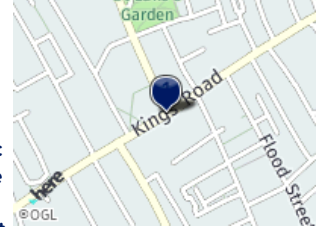
