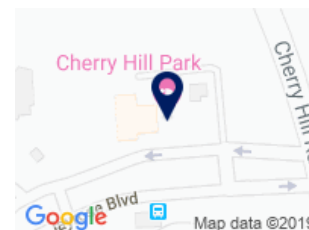

Cherry Hill Park

With College Park Aviation Museum reachable in 7 km, Cherry Hill Park provides accommodation, a restaurant, a seasonal outdoor swimming pool, a garden and a fitness centre. Complimentary WiFi is featured. The camping provides guests with a patio, a seating area, satellite flat-screen TV, a fully equipped kitchen with a dishwasher and a microwave, and a private bathroom with shower and a hair dryer. A fridge and coffee machine are also provided. The wellness area at Cherry Hill Park is comprised of a hot tub and a sauna. A water park is available on site and both cycling and fishing can be enjoyed within close proximity of the accommodation. The nearest airport is Ronald Reagan Washington National, 29 km from Cherry Hill Park, and the property offers a free shuttle service.

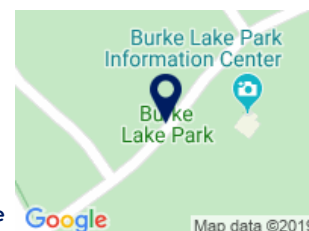

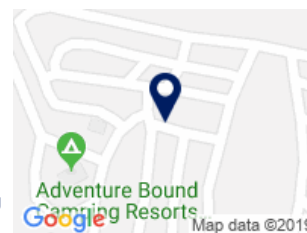
